
## Woollypetals Bowtie Pattern

- cut 2 bowtie pattern pieces out on fold
- cut 1 tie pattern piece
- cut one strip of fabric 1.75'' wide x the width around the shirt neck plus 2'' for velcro overlap
- with right sides together sewn around bowtie pieces leave an opening to turn.
- turn right side out, press flat, sew up opening
- next sew the long side of the tie piece with right sides together making a cylinder, turn
- do the same to the strip of fabric for the neckstrap
- lay out bowtie flat, fold on dotted lines, "fold" on pattern is the middle of the tie, dotted line 1 fold to the back, dotted line 2 fold to the front.
- hopefully you have a bowtie. :) Now I zigzag the bowtie down the middle to hold it so I can set it down
- sew 1.5" long piece of velcro to each end of the strap so they will overlap. lay strap behind middle of bowtie.
- take tie and wrap around middle of bowtie, make sure the strap is in the circle too. slipstitch tie in the back so it is nice and tight.

## Supplies:

- pattern pieces
- fabric (1/4yd or less)
- 1.5"x .5" velcro
- needle & thread (sewing machine)
- also cut 1.75" x circumference
  of shirt neck piece + 2"
  from fabric

Printing at 100% will produce the size I used in both bowties.
