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## woollypetals Wash Your Paws Quilt Pattern

Quilt Size 63" Square

#### Please read all instructions prior to sewing.


\*Size can be adjusted by making the borders larger or smaller.

Note: increasing or decreasing size will change the amount of background fabric required.

This pattern is traditionally pieced and uses the Half Square Triangle method. I will refer to Half Square Triangles as HST or HSTs in the pattern from now on.

**HST = Half Square Triangle** 

WOF = Width of Fabric



Fabric	Fabric Color	Yardage
Fabric 1	Yellow	1/4 yd or fat quarter
Fabric 2	Coral	1/2 yd
Fabric 3	Purple	3/4 yd
Fabric 4	Blue	3/4 yd
Fabric 5	Brown	1/2 yd nondirectional fabric 1 yd directional fabric
Background	White	2 yds

Fabric Requirements:

**Cutting Instructions:** 

WOF = width of fabric

Fabric 1: 1/4 yd cuts:

4 - 6.5" squares

1 – 3.5" square

Cut 1 fabric strip 6.5" tall X WOF

Cut strip into 4 - 6.5" squares

Cut 1 - 3.5" square from remaining fabric

Alternate fat quarter cuts:

Cut 2 fabric strips 6.5" tall X 21" wide

Cut 1st strip into 3 - 6.5" squares

Cut 2<sup>nd</sup> strip into 1 - 6.5" square

Cut 1 - 3.5" square from remaining fabric

Fabric 2:

12 - 6.5" squares

Cut 2 fabric strips 6.5" tall X WOF

Cut strips into 12 – 6.5" squares

Fabric 3:

20 - 6.5" squares

Cut 3 strips 6.5" tall X WOF

Cut strips into 20 - 6.5" squares

Fabric 4:

12 - 7.5" squares

Cut 3 fabric strips 7.5" tall X WOF

Cut strips into 12 – 7.5" squares

Fabric 5:

4 – 3.5" wide X 30.5" long strips

**Nondirectional Fabric** 

Cut fabric into 4 - 3.5" tall strips X WOF

Cut each strip to 30.5" wide

\*Directional Fabric

Cut using cutting diagram on page 7

**Background Fabric:** 

4 - 6.5" squares

12 - 7.5" squares

4 - 6.5" wide X 24.5" long borders

4 - 6.5" wide X 30.5" long borders


Cut using cutting diagrams on page 7

\*Cutting diagrams show how to cut background fabric directionally. The diagram may have some waste, but cutting this way requires less fabric.


#### **Sewing Instructions for HSTs:**

Sew 24 HSTs using 12 – 7.5" background squares and 12 – 7.5" Fabric 4 (blue) squares.

1. Lay 1 (fabric 4) 7.5" square + 1 (white background fabric) 7.5" square right sides together.



Mark a line corner to corner on the wrong side of the background square.
Sew 1/4" away from middle line on either side.
Cut on marked line to separate the sewn sides.



3. Press HSTs open and Trim each to 6.5" square. You now have two HST's half background fabric(white) half Fabric 4 (blue).




#### Lay out Quilt:

This quilt is made up of 4 Bear Paws.

Layout 1 Paw at a time and sew it together.

\*Remember if you have directional fabric you will need to rotate the block 90° each time so your fabric is facing the correct direction.

Optional: Layout whole quilt at one time, but sew in single Paw sections.



#### Sewing Instructions for 1 Paw:

Set aside the borders: 24.5" X 6.5" and 30.5" X 6.5" background fabric pieces.

Sew each row of squares together, following the diagram for placement.

Sew the rows of squares together, following the diagram for placement.


Now you have 1 Paw section that is a 4 X4 of squares.

#### Add the borders to Paw:


Sew the 24.5" X 6.5" border to the top of the Paw section.

Sew the 30.5" X 6.5" border to left side of the Paw section.

Repeat process 3 times to complete 4 Paws total.



### **Directional Paw Diagrams:**



#### **Completing Top:**

Use the 4 (Fabric 5) 3.5" X 30.5" sashing pieces + 1 (Fabric 1) 3.5" square.


Sew one (Fabric 5) long sashing piece to each side of the (Fabric 1) 3.5" square to make a 63.5" long piece of sashing.

Sew one Paw to each side of each of the leftover 3.5" X 30.5" (Fabric 5) pieces.

\*Pay attention to direction of Paws before sewing to sashing.


Sew top Paw set (Paw + sashing + Paw) to the top of the 63.5" long sashing you made first.

Sew bottom Paw set (Paw + sashing + Paw) to the bottom of above.



Your quilt top is done. Enjoy!
