
woollypetals Camp Mushroom


Small Mushroom Block 15" square - uses 8.5" square found treasure textile.

Large Mushroom Block 20" square - uses 12.5" square found treasure textile.

Make a Camp Mushroom Block using found textiles. Vintage quilt blocks, hankies, a loved one's clothing item, tablecloths, the sky's the limit.

Fabric requirements:	15" block	20" block
Found textile or Fabric of Choice:	8.5" square	12.5" square
Mushroom Stem :	6" square	7" square
Background: non-directional fabric	Fat quarter	Fat quarter






Cut List:	15" Block	20" Block
Piece A: Trim found textile to	8.5" square	12.5" square
Piece B: Cut 1 per block	3.5"w x 5.5"t	4.5"w x 6.5"t
Piece C: Cut 2 per block	2.5" square	4.5" square
Piece D: Cut 2 per block	1" square	1.5" square
Piece E: Cut 2 per block	3"w x 5.5"t	4.5"w x 6.5"t
Piece F: Cut 2 per block	4"w x 13.5"t	4.5"w x 18.5"t
Piece G: Cut 2 per block	15.5"w x 1.5"t	20.5"w x 1.5"t

Sewing Instructions:

1/4" seam allowance. Stitch'N'Flip diagram to right.

Press as needed between each step.

- Stitch'N'Flip Piece Cs to the top corners of Piece A to make the mushroom cap.
- Stitch'N'Flip Piece Ds to the bottom corners of Piece B to make the mushroom stem.
- Sew a Piece E to either side of mushroom stem.
- Sew the mushroom stem + Es to the bottom of the mushroom cap to make the mushroom.
- Sew a Piece F to either side of the mushroom.
- Sew a Piece G to the top and bottom of the mushroom + Fs.
- Your Camp Mushroom is sewn!



Other things to make from the Camp Mushroom Block; A tote bag, a pillow, the back of a quilted vest or jacket, or make several blocks into a small quilt.
